ILR Show Division

- The ILR Show Division (ILR-SD) was implemented in January 2009 in response to the request of the ILR members for a new show association. Two independent groups of ILR members sent proposals to the ILR Board of Directors outlining proposed structures for a show association.
- The ILR-SD has seven active committees that have structured the rules and recommendations for the ILR-SD. The chairperson of each committee, along with the ILR Board, serve as the Governing Board for the ILR-SD. Committee members serve a five year term and were appointed by the ILR BOD the first year and have been elected from the ILR membership beginning in 2010.



Why Join the ILR-SD:

- Giving Members what they want: When the ILR Board surveyed the membership about what they wanted from the new ILR-SD, there were five main things they hoped for: Flexibility in show structure, Economical to show, Accurate Results, Timely Results and Fun. The ILR-SD committees have worked hard to incorporate all these into the structure of the ILR-SD.
- Show Sanctioning: To be an ILR-SD sanctioned show, the show must pay a \$50 sanctioning fee and use an ILR-SD approved judge. There are no mandatory classes in ILR-SD shows—we recognize the regional differences in the lama industry and encourage local shows management to creatively structure a show that meets the needs of their area.
- Costs: The sanctioning fee includes use of the ILR ShowManager, a software program that utilizes the ILR database to verify animal/owner information, can be customized to fit your show, prints a show program and uploads the show results onto the ILR website. Show management must also pay a per head/show user fee. For shows choosing not to use the ShowManager, the cost also covers the staff entering the results per head/show into SM in addition to the sanctioning fee.
- Advantages of Membership: ILR-SD members will have their points for the animal placings automatically recorded for them, and they are eligible for year-end and lifetime awards. Non-members may still show at an ILR-SD sanctioned show without paying a non-member fee, but no points will be tracked and they will not be eligible for ILR-SD awards.
