

Requirements for the ILR-SD (ILR Show Division) and ILR-UAP (Universal Awards Program) Awards

 \underline{COA} – Certificates of Achievement are awarded in Halter, Performance, and/or Beyond the Showring Divisions when a llama earns $\underline{25 \text{ points}}$ in a division. A COA can be earned in each division.

 \underline{COE} – Certificates of Excellence are awarded in Halter, Performance, and/or Beyond the Showring Divisions when a llama earns <u>40 points</u> in a division. A COE can be earned in each division.

<u>COC</u> – ILR-SD Champion – Certificates of Championship and a Trophy are awarded in Halter and/or Performance Divisions when a llama earns 40 points plus 4 Grand Championships <u>OR</u> 40 points plus 3 Grand Championships and 2 Reserved Grand Championships. A COC can be earned in each division.

Summary for COC:

- 1) Obtain 40 points and 4 Grands per division OR
- 2) Obtain 40 points, 3 Grands and 2 Reserve Grands per division

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

You must be a member of the ILR-SD at the time of the ILR sanctioned show in order to qualify for ILR-SD points. Points from ILR sanctioned shows are automatically entered for ILR Show Division members.

You must be an ILR member at the time of the show/activity to obtain UAP points. UAP points from ILR sanctioned shows are automatically entered. Individuals must enter the information themselves into the UAP log for non-ILR sanctioned shows and other activities. The UAP Log is located on the ILR website. Log in and choose UAP Activity Log under the Common Quick Links tab.
