Judges Committee Meeting - Minutes

Old Business:

Jerrika emailed the committee members the first draft of the virtual judging clinic agenda with resource ideas. The committee will take the next couple months to review the proposed clinic agenda and bring change suggestions to our next meeting.

New Business:

On May 3rd, 2022, Isaac Beck requested admission to the apprentice program having reached his 18th birthday. Fran made a motion to approve the request, Nick seconded, unanimous approval, motion passed. Steve will make a recommendation to the Governing Board to approve.

On May 11th, 2022, Eugene Robinson petitioned the Judges Committee to become a certified judge having completed the required apprenticeships and receiving positive reviews from the judges he apprenticed under. Fran made a motion to approve the request, Nick seconded, unanimous approval, motion passed. Steve will make a recommendation to the Governing Board to approve.

On May 17th, 2022, Elaine Brovont petitioned the Judges Committee to become a teaching judge in HPY&F. Elaine presented a letter highlighting her experience as a teacher as well as her required judging assignments over the past 2 years. The Judges Committee is in receipt of just one of three required letters of recommendation for Elaine. Tabling further consideration until the other two letters of recommendation are received.
