PERFORMANCE

Entry fees - \$5.00 Sub-Junior - \$10.00 Youth - \$15.00 Adult - \$10.00 Maiden - Ribbons will be awarded for 1st - 5th place in each class. Performance Grand and Reserve Champion will be awarded ribbons, must have entered in all 3 classes. Sub-Juniors will be awarded special ribbons. Youth Performance classes will pay \$15.00 for 1st , \$10.00 for 2nd, and \$5.00 for 3rd. Maiden classes are open to any animal that has never entered a Performance Class. (Non ILR point) . Maiden Performance will pay \$50.00 for the overall winner, must enter in all 3 maiden classes.

HALTER

Entry Fees - Youth Showmanship \$10.00 - Get & Produce \$20.00 - All other classes \$30.00 Ribbons will be awarded for 1st - 5th place in each class. Grand and Reserve Champion will be awarded ribbons and special prize. Get of Sire consists of three animals & Produce of Dame consists of two animals. Both are double point classes. To register in ILR - Only register the Sire or Dam. Do Not register the offspring. Not Registering through ILR or if the Sire or Dam is Deceased, include a copy of ILR Certificate or have the correct full name and ILR #.

FLEECE

Fees - Shorn and Fleece-on \$15 - Products \$5.00 - \$3.00 ILR Judging Fee in Shorn for a llama not in the show. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st - 5th place in each class. Grand and Reserve Champion in Shorn and Fleece-on will be awarded ribbons and special prize. *Fleece Products:* Bring your items to the show and sign them in. Judge will assign divisions. A Judge's Choice Award will be awarded in Products.

LLAMA AGE DIVISIONS

Juvenile: (5 mos. to <12 mos.) Yearling: (12 mos. to <24 mos.)

Mature: (Over 24 mos.)

Animal age on day of show will be used to determine appropriate class

YOUTH AGES

<u>Sub-Junior</u> Youth (Under 7) <u>Junior</u> Youth - (7 - 11 yrs.) <u>Intermediate</u> Youth (12 - 14 yrs.) <u>Senior</u> Youth (15 - 19 yrs.)

The age division in which the youth will show will be determined by their age on January 1st 2023, however, if a youth reaches the age of 7 any time during the year, they will be eligible to show as of their birth date, when a Senior Youth reaches their 20th birthday they are no longer egible to show in the Youth division at all. Intact males 18 months and older are restricted from being shown in the Junior Youth age division classes, due to safety concerns. Check the ILR Youth Guidelines for more information.
