MEETING MINUTES

October 11, 2022

ILR Fleece Committee Conference Call.

Meeting called to order by Julie at 6:04 pm MST

Reading and Approval of May 2022 minutes. Joy motioned to approve the approval of the minutes. Bonnie Doble seconds to approve the May minutes. All in favor. Motion passes to approve the May 2022 minutes.

Unfinished Business

1. Julie provided a report from the Governing Board meeting.

New Business

1. Julie proposed several fleece guideline questions for the committee to review/discuss:
 - a. Like shorn fleece, is there a timeline for entering Fleece Products? The committee discussed and agreed that it should be 2 years, same for shorn fleece, for fleece products.
 - b. The entry tag needs an area to self-identify exhibitor either Novice, Advanced, or Youth. P. 53 & 119
 - c. Warp & weft definitions needs to move to Definitions for Fleece Product Evaluation. Also, Sett needs a definition. P. 62 & 119

- d. Looking at the score card, we may want to consider the appropriateness of “Uniformity” for the class of Other Misc. p 123. Some products might not be uniform, such as instant pictures, decorative items.
- e. Felting has “Durable” as an area to judge. Julie has a concern with this. Some items need to be very durable, i.e. hats, rugs, some scarves. However, some areas do not need to be durable in the same sense, for example, decorative items, or hangs on the walls. Julie recommends to move the “Less Durable” items to “Other”.

The fleece committee agreed with Julies 5 recommendations listed above.

- 2. Committee members need to each share their email and phone numbers for optimal communication within the committee. We plan to try out Google Meet or Zoom for our next committee meeting. Bonnie Kittrell offered to set the next meeting up as long as she gets individual email addresses for each committee member.
- 3. Julie mentioned she will further investigate how to get the Fleece Committee meeting minutes uploaded to the ILR website. The May 2022 Fleece Committee meeting minutes are not on the ILR website. Joy mentioned the ILR website has been hijacked and that the Governing Board is working out a solution.
- 4. Julie asked each member of the Fleece Committee for input on the questions to be submitted to the Governing board for the Fleece Judge Evaluation. Bonnie Kittrell offered to come up with the 5 questions and share with the committee prior to the next Governing Board Meeting.
