Topic of Discussion:

- Mutual agreement by all members in attendance, The silky division is placed between suri and the coverage classes for a good reason. Animals entered in suri that don't quite fit can be moved to silky, and animals that don't fit silky can be moved to their appropriate coverage class.
- Silky is a type class not a coverage class so silky animals can be shown in Silky OR their appropriate coverage class based on the guidelines.
- Decision was to leave the Silky Class where it is, ultimately the order of classes is up to the discretion of the show superintendent, but the suggested order will remain: Suri, Silky, Classic/Light, Medium, Heavy.
