OFFICE REPORT – Susan

- Computer system and Website Update- Allen Schott recommends A Server with solid state drive (\$7644.00) His comments were: It is superfast, 100% Dell servers with 3 years next business day on site service.
- Llama transfer/ lost registration- Identifying microchip and photos of the llama allowed Susan to locate this llamas ILR registration. Owner requests to transfer the llama into their name. Linda made a motion to allow the transfer and registration of this llama (per found matching microchip & identifying photos) Ramona seconded the motion, motion passed unanimously.
